The Aztecs' Social Organization

Tlatoani	king-priest, who was a military chief, supreme judge, and representative of the gods. He shared power with the Supreme Council, made up of the capullec (the chiefs of the calpulli, groups of families who were assigned a common piece of land).
Nobility	made up of family of the Tlatoani as well as the city's princes, priests, military chiefs, and capullec; they received tributes from other social groups.
Pochtecas	merchants who also had a privileged social and economic position.
Macehualtin	largest part of the population, made up of agricultural workers, laborers, and artisans.
Serfs or slaves	lowest social position - serfs were free, but were forced to work for the state or for specific people. Slaves were controlled by their masters and did not have rights, and sometimes they were offered as sacrifices during religious ceremonies.
